ORDER

By order dated December 8, 2022, Judge Wilkins dismissed complaints filed against six Judges of the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit and the United States District Court for the District of Columbia. On January 6, 2023, the complainant filed with the Judicial Council a pleading which the Judicial Council has construed as containing a petition for review of the order of dismissal. Upon consideration thereof, it is

ORDERED, by the Judicial Council acting pursuant to Rule 25(g) of the *Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings*, that for the reasons set forth in the memorandum accompanying the order dismissing the complaints, the disposition is affirmed and the petition for review is denied pursuant to Rule 19(b)(1).
